


Fig: Community-Based Mental Health Support Outreach, Organized by KSVAMC & RC, Shobhit University, Gangoh at Sangatheda




Fig: Youth Leadership and Health Empowerment Drive, Organized by KSVAMC & RC, Shobhit University, Gangoh at Bhagwanpur




Fig: Community Nutrition and Health Awareness Drive organized by KSVAMC & RC, Shobhit University, Gangoh at Nagalrajput


